Introduction of new 3.4 meter wide fixation unit at Fespa Berlin

At Fespa Berlin SETeMa B.V. has shown their new 3400 mm (133.9") wide fixation unit for the fixation of all textile dyes, the Portafix Universal 3400.

The Portafix Universal 3400 is designed specifically for the wide format textile printing market and is suitable for all fabrics printed with water based dyes including nylon and polyester, the typically used materials for flag and banner printing.

Reviewing the Fespa we can say that, with the increase of digital print production, more and more customers are looking for compact high quality industrial fixation units (of steamers?). Remarkable was the relative large number of customers interested in a steaming solution for Reactive and Acid dyes for fashion, home deco and accessories. A few large format polyester printers are also orientating towards environmental friendly natural fibers like cotton.

With the availability in 3 widths in 1.85, 2.5 and 3.4 meters and 4 capacities, along with the possibility to upgrade to a higher capacity afterwards, SETeMa makes fixation equipment that fits the needs of digital printers and is able to grow with them, customers say. The new modular infeed and outfeed gives a range of winding and unwinding possibilities. With the proven concept customers have a reliable steamer solution for a day to day reproducible dyestuff fixation.

With the possibility to combine all Portafix-Universal fixation units with the successfully Porta-Clean each customer can build its specific versatile line for fixation, washing and drying. The availability of the Porta-Clean stand-alone is a perfect supplement in the growing range of finishing equipment of SETeMa.
